Dear Mr. McGowan-


In response to your latest letter, I can unequivocally state that my people (Mr. Alexander and his affiliates) had absolutely nothing to do with the unauthorized distribution of the film, "The Profit" and we have gone to great efforts to stop any further transmissions. For your records, I am enclosing some of the DMCA copyright violation notices. We all acted swiftly and formally, as these e-mail records show. We were successful in getting You Tube to discontinue any further broadcast, and we are responding to any additional information regarding unauthorized transmissions that are brought to our attention.

For the record, my people believe that they are the only ones that actually hope the film is exhibited legitimately and actually makes some money. If your client was even remotely concerned with these unauthorized transmissions, he could have sent out DMCA notices as responsible member of the LLC. Where were those? The point of using these current events as a basis to criticize my client, rather than take decisive action to protect the film, the only asset of the LLC, is transparently repugnant. While we (including my client, myself, and others experienced in dealing with copyright issues on the internet) have quickly responded to any and all illegal postings, my people believe it was either Mr. Minton, or one of his agents, who posted the film illegally, in order to give him some manufactured or false grounds for some type of adverse actions or action against my client, so that Minton can fulfill his presumed agreement with the Church of Scientology to find any means whatsoever to "harass and destroy utterly" his former "partner," Mr. Alexander, as is the policy of the entity whom my people believe is your actual client, the Church of Scientology.

Additionally, please note that the first illegal posting was done at 5PM on a Friday, the end of the work week, a time when my client was unable to contact me to take immediate action. I proceeded with the action to remove the film, as did Mr. Alexander, working the weekend, as soon as we perceived there was a problem.

In closing, please advise your client(s) that Mr. Alexander has no more control over the illegal leaking of "The Profit" than *they* do over the posting of Church videos of Tom Cruise discussing his "wins" in Scientology, or dancing at his birthday party, or the televised speeches of Mr. Miscavige at Scientology events posted on the internet, which, to date, I am told were NEVER taken down, despite efforts of the Church to remove them. Bottom line: we are doing everything we can to protect the only asset of the LLC, and if Mr. Minton truly wants to recoup his investment, I would expect your swift responsive communiqué, indicating his full approval to immediately initiate legitimate marketing of this important work. Obviously, any reluctance on his part to act in the best interests of the LLC by agreeing to same will be telling. Thank you for your consideration. I am sure I will hear from you soon.
